

Greater Seattle Business Association (GSBA) and Pride Foundation Scholarships

Eligibility:

- Applicants must be a resident of **Washington, Oregon, Idaho, Montana, or Alaska** but may study elsewhere. Applicants are considered a "resident" of one of these states if they:
 - a. currently live within that state and have done so for at least three months prior to the application deadline; **or**
 - b. have lived within that state for at least one year at any time within the five years prior to the application deadline; **or**
 - c. have lived within that state for more than one year at any time and have been continuously enrolled in an accredited academic institution for the five years prior to the application deadline.
- Preference is given to students who are **self-identified LGBT**, members of **LGBT families**, or **straight-allies** who have been strongly supportive of the LGBT community.
- All scholarships emphasize **demonstrated commitment to human and civil rights for all people**.

Award Amount:

The minimum scholarship amount is \$500 and our largest scholarship is \$10,000. Since students may be awarded more than one scholarship totals vary. The average amount award per recipient was over \$3000 last year.
