Think visually when signing numbers. If you were describing an athlete's jersey number, where would you place the numbers? That's right — in front of your chest!

I Want to Know . . .

Do numbers 16-19 have to include the number 10?

Some Deaf people sign the numbers 16, 17, 18, and 19 without beginning with the number 10. You will not see this variant used as often as the style shown on page 69. In the general style, the signer says 10 (plus) 6 to mean 16 and follows the pattern up to 19. While the number 10 is not made with the variant style of numbers 16 through 19, the wrist flick conveys the number 10. Become familiar with both styles and follow the system used by your local Deaf community.
