Where Are the Advisors' Calendars?

Some of you have been asking: "Where is the clipboard with the Advisors' Calendars?" Our answer: They are no longer available! In order to assist our international students more accurately and efficiently, the International Education Programs decided to operate advisors' calendars electronically.

Depending on the topic you would like to discuss, we will help you decide whether you need an appointment with an advisor or not. If an appointment is necessary, here are the steps to schedule an appointment:

1. IEP will check your Student ID or other types of photo identification and you will be given a small piece of neon yellow paper—the Appointment Reminder.
2. List the available times you can see an advisor on the Appointment Reminder.
3. One of our staff will review the advisors' calendars and search for available time slots that match your preferred times.
4. Once we are able to match you with the advisor's available time slot, we will indicate the appointment time on the Appointment Reminder.

When you return for your appointment time...

1. Please bring the Appointment Reminder with you and check in at the Front Desk. It will help us assist you faster.
2. You must show your Photo ID.
3. Don't be late! If you are late for 10 minutes or more, you will need to reschedule the appointment.
4. Please bring all the documents required for your appointment.
