## ***The Business Pathway***

From banking and finance to marketing, accounting and management, the Business Pathway at Seattle Central Community College offers many diverse opportunities for students interested in a career in business.

There are many pathways in the business field to match your values, interests and abilities. For example, if you are competitive, persuasive and ambitious you may consider a career in marketing or sales. If you enjoy organizing, analyzing and processing data, a career in accounting or financial analysis may suit you best. Whatever your area of interest, you will be well-prepared for today's job market.

Students interested in pursuing a bachelor's degree should complete the Associate of Arts transfer degree and include the core business prerequisite courses detailed below. Many business programs are highly

competitive; we recommend that you apply to more than one business school for admission.

Seattle Central Community College also offers Certificates and Associate of Applied Science degrees in **Business Information Technology** and **Information Technology**. Depending on articulated agreements, these programs may or may not transfer to a baccalaureate degree program.

By completing the courses outlined below, you should be well-prepared for entrance into most business schools in and out of Washington State.

Be sure to check the admission and graduation requirements of your transfer university, as requirements change and some universities require specific courses that may not be offered at a community college.
