Fine, Visual & Performing Arts Pathway

The Arts Pathway is for students who enjoy creative and visual expression. Artistic types are often described as imaginative, intuitive and innovative. They typically prefer unstructured and flexible work environments that allow for self-expression. Some students prefer the design and technical aspects of studying art, while others enjoy performing or developing an appreciation for the arts.

The fine and visual arts (B.A. and B.F.A.) require foundation courses in drawing, design, art history and a variety of courses in studio areas. The B.F.A. also requires intensive specialization in a studio area and may require an extra year of course work. Long hours in the studio are common.

Seattle Central Community College offers certificate programs in **Arts Management and Graphic Design & Illustration, Graphic Imaging & Printing Technology** and Associate of Applied Science degrees in **Apparel Design & Services, Film & Video Communications, Graphic Design and Illustration, Graphic Imaging & Printing**

Technology and Commercial Photography. Depending on articulated agreements, these programs may or may not transfer to a baccalaureate degree program.

For students who are interested in pursuing a Bachelor of Arts (B.A.) or a Bachelor of Fine Arts (B.F.A.), the Associate of Arts transfer degree at SCCC is the option of choice. Students should not expect their courses to transfer as exact equivalents, as admission and placement is usually based on auditions or a portfolio of your best work. Programs in the fine, visual and performing arts are highly competitive, so we recommend that you apply to more than one college or university for admission. It is important that you work closely with instructors and advisors to help you prepare for transfer.

Be sure to check the admission and graduation requirements of your transfer university, as requirements may change and some programs require specific courses that may not be offered at community colleges.
