The two-year Associate's degree from Seattle Central Community College is your key to transferring to hundreds of colleges and universities in the United States. However, you can also choose to receive a Transfer Admission Guarantee\* even before you leave your home country. The Transfer Admission Guarantee is in the form of a conditional letter of admission from one of our partner institutions. You can show your four-year university conditional admission letter to the U.S. Embassy or Consulate as you explain your academic goals and obtain your student visa.

\*Specific transfer GPA and other requirements apply. University admission agreements are subject to general university policies which may change based on demographic or economic conditions. Please check with the IEP office at Seattle Central ([iepsccc@sccd.ctc.edu](mailto:iepsccc@sccd.ctc.edu)) for any updated policies that may be in effect.

### Steps To Your 4-Year Degree

1. Submit SCCC application, indicating your transfer preference
2. Receive admission from SCCC and a conditional letter of admission from one of our university partners
3. Interview at U.S. embassy or consulate and apply for F-1 visa
4. Complete first two years of Bachelor's degree at Seattle Central
5. Complete last two years of Bachelor's degree at a partner university
6. Receive Bachelor's degree

### Frequently Asked Questions

**When** will I be conditionally accepted to the partner institution?

When you apply for admission to Seattle Central, you may choose one of our partner institutions from which to receive your Transfer Admission Guarantee. You will receive the conditional letter of admission from the university you have chosen, along with the acceptance material from Seattle Central.

**When** do I transfer?

Transfer to the partner institution should occur within one year of completing your Associate's degree at Seattle Central.

**What** if I do not want to finish my Associate's degree at Seattle Central?

Completion of the Associate's degree is a requirement of the Transfer Admission Guarantee. If you do not finish your Associate's degree, you will be required to complete the regular admission process at the partner institution.

**Will** the partner institutions accept all of the courses I complete at Seattle Central?

They will accept college level academic coursework.

**How** long will it take to complete a Bachelor's degree?

Depending on your program of study, it will take about two years to complete your Bachelor's degree. We strongly encourage you to define your academic plan at the beginning of your studies at Seattle Central.
