

Mathematica for Students – Macintosh Instructions

Version 7.0.0

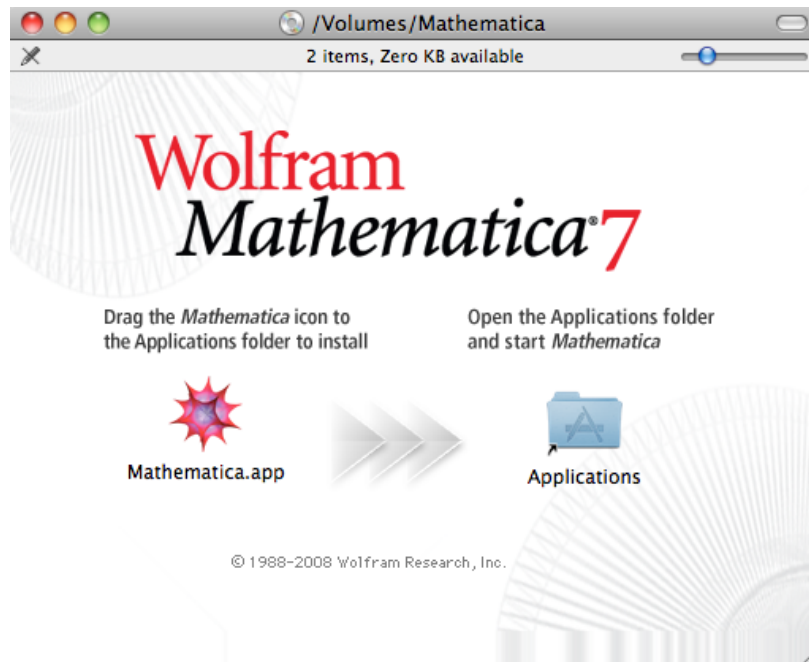
Instructions for installing Mathematica on your home computer. The entire installation and activation process will take about 15 – 20 minutes.

There are two main steps to the process. The first step is installation of the program files. The second step is acquiring a password.

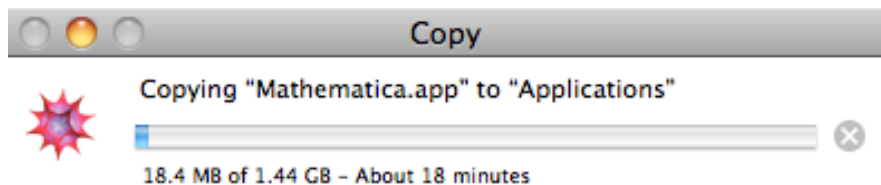
You should close all programs before starting. It is assumed that you have an internet connection available since at Step 6 you will be connected to the Mathematica website to register and request a password. You will also need to connect to your email account to receive the password that will be sent to you.

Place the DVD in the drive.

1. The disk image window should appear as below. If it does not, open the Finder, locate the DVD icon, and double click to open it.



2. Drag the Mathematica.app icon into the Applications folder. The files should start copying:



3. Open the Applications folder and start Mathematica. The Product Activation screen will appear.
4. Select Single-Machine License (if this is not already checked) then enter your name. For organization enter Seattle Central C.C. For license number enter the license number provided to you by your instructor. Then press OK. (This button will not become “live” unless your license number is valid.)





5. Press the Web button to begin the process of getting your password. You will be connected to the Wolfram web site. Note that you will return to this screen after your password is emailed to you. Don't close this screen.


